VINEYARD

DE TIZA Pinot Noir comes from very extreme vineyards, planted on lime-rich soils (limestone) and with a coastal influence, marked by the proximity to the Pacific Ocean. They are located on the third terrace of the southern plateau of the Huasco Valley. The soils are of alluvial origin, very poor, with less than 1% organic matter and very particular characteristics in terms of moisture retention. The vineyard was planted by Daniel Llorente for a family project at the former Hacienda Buena Esperanza.

TYPE OF PLANTING

Vertical trellis/6,250 plants per hectare.

WINE

De Tiza is a Pinot Noir with a lot of character. It delivers notes of gunpowder, peat, with a background of red fruits that add freshness. The palate is tense and asserts itself well on the palate with its tannins. It is a low extraction red, seeking greater delicacy in the fruit. In this vintage it was vinified with 50% whole cluster.

VINIFICATION

Manual harvest in 10 kg trays. The grapes are vinified in stainless steel vats, with 50% whole cluster and the other 50% destemmed. Cold maceration for 3 days. Fermentation for 9 days. Post fermentation maceration for 7 days.
