VINEYARD

The vineyard is located on slopes of granite soil, without irrigation (dry-farmed), cultivated as bush vines (goblet) and on original rootstock (franc de pied), phylloxera free.

Surface: 3 hectares (ha)

Plants/ha: 5,000 Yield: 6,000 kg/ha

WINEMAKING

The grapes are hand harvested in small crates when ripe, completely de-stemmed and transferred into original, very old Chilean amphorae. Vinification is natural, with indigenous yeasts inducing spontaneous fermentation. The wine matures for about 10 months on skins. At the end of the aging the wine is bottled with a small addition of sulphites (less then 15 mg/L in total), unfined and unfiltered.
